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CaIMHSA CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY
WITH

SECTION 1: PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to define a conflict of interest and to establish a procedure for recognizing and reporting conflict of interest issues.

SECTION 2: POLICY

CaIMHSA promotes business practices that comply with conflict of interest and disclosure requirements, including but not limited to, the California Political Reform Act of 1974 and California Government Code sections 1090-1097 and 1125-1129. When a Board member, staff member, contractor or agent in a position to influence a decision or who has decision making power identifies a conflict of interest, that person must state that he or she has a conflict and decline to participate in or give consideration to the matter from that point forward.
