



PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT OF SDR CONSORTIUM MEETING 10/29/12

On October 29, 2012 from 9:30-5:00pm, the Statewide Stigma & Discrimination Reduction (SDR) Consortium will hold a working meeting. The Consortium is administered by California Mental Health Services Authority (CalMHSa) and is funded by the voter approved Mental Health Services Act (Prop. 63).

The Consortium is an advisory body to the CalMHSa Stigma & Discrimination Reduction Initiative and also serves as a resource to the other Initiatives under the CalMHSa Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Program. In this capacity, the Consortium provides feedback on materials, products and tools as well as recommendations on outreach to broader communities among its networks as a way to extend the reach of the SDR and other PEI initiatives.
