

RESOLUTION OF THE SISKIYOU COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, The Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) has funding for state-wide initiatives when multiple counties collaborate, and

WHEREAS, The California Mental Health Services Authority Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement provides the opportunity for the County of Siskiyou to directly participate in and benefit from state-wide projects,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Siskiyou County Board of Supervisors that

1. Adopt a resolution stating intent to participate in the California Counties Mental Health Services Authority, a joint powers authority (JPA), with other California counties to develop and fund mental health services and education programs on a regional or state-wide basis.
2. Authorize the Director of Behavioral Health Services or designees to act as a representative of the County of Siskiyou in the JPA.
3. Authorize the Director of Behavioral Health Services to sign the CalMHSA JPA agreement dated June 10, 2010.

The foregoing resolution was adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Siskiyou, State of California, held on the 2nd day of November, 2010 by the following vote:




