


Measuring Behavior Change

Kooth developed the first validated outcome measure for single session therapy

SWAN-OM: Session Wants and Needs Outcome Measure

- Person-centered measure focused on asset/strengths-based approach
- 3-year research and engineering project
- Independently validated by Child Outcomes Research Consortium

72% of users achieve their 'Session Wants and Needs'



Safety first!

- → All user-generated content is pre-moderated before going live on the platform
- → Soluna's anonymous model protects service-user identity
- → Robust safeguarding policies for risk management (suicide ideation, etc.)
- → Service users cannot directly message each other; no possibility for inappropriate content or interactions



Soluna can be seamlessly integrated into standard care in three ways to support youth and prevent gaps

Soluna is being used statewide and reaching underserved communities*

- Users in all 58 Counties
- 53% users underserved
- 170+ school districts
- ~45k registered users *



Soluna is accessed outside of traditional **hours** when users need it*

- 50% sessions outside of 9-5
- Less than 90s wait for a coach



Users love coaching and are feeling a positive impact*

- 97% felt heard, understood, and respected
- 97% give positive feedback on coaching
- 85% had at least one need met in single session

Connecting Communities to Resources with Care

We have a comprehensive database of local resources and a carefully curated Affiliate Network designed to build trusted and engaged partnerships with local organizations.

Our care navigation team ensures Service Users receive the care and support they need from vetted Affiliate Network partners.

- → Extensive Database of carefully curated local resources
- Direct relationships with vetted partners to ensure high quality support

Affiliate Network and Bilingual Care Coordinators:

- → English and Spanish-speaking coordinators provide accessible and personalized assistance
- → Coordinators assess each Service User's (SU) circumstances to connect them with low or no-cost services when needed.
- → Recommendations are feedback-driven, incorporating the SU's voice into every decision.
- → Coordinators are trained to reflect the language, culture, and lived experiences of the communities they serve.

Why we have Care Navigation and Affiliate Network Partners

Navigating healthcare is complex. Through Care Navigation, we aim to take the confusion and complication off of the shoulders of the SUs.

The purpose of the Affiliate Network is to develop trusted and engaged partnerships with local organizations that will support Soluna members in receiving care and support beyond what our resources provide.

Our Off Platform Team is seeking Partners that:

- → Serve families with children and youth ages 13-25
- → Provide youth mental/behavioral services, physical health, and/or community resources
- → Have capacity to take on new clients

Additional Considerations:

- → Bilingual/multilingual services
- → Provide culturally sensitive services including support for BIPOC and LGBTA+ populations
